

Suspended Architectural Canopy, Dresden

Exterior Light

Concept/Design. The Ammonhof Dresden is an office and administrative center whose unusual architecture is appreciated not only by its tenants but also by the city's many inhabitants. The prominent feature of this building is the Atrium. A suspended architectural canopy positively influences both light

and acoustics while providing the inner space with a sheltered atmosphere.

Construction. The 450 m² canopy is suspended beneath a glass construction and is secured at fixed points on the wall.
